Please submit the following for scholarship consideration.

Two (2) writing samples, published in newspaper, magazine, book or online, or written/pre-published during the last two years; maximum of 8 pages per piece.

Necessary for consideration:

- * Five (5) legible copies of each submission, to be sent. Entries without 5 copies or submitted via e-mail or fax will not be accepted.
- * All references to writer's name and/or publication where writing was presented must be removed.
- * A short biography and this application form (1 copy of each)

Judges will score for writing style (50 points), knowledge of subject matter (20 points), topic and creative approach (20 points) and relevance - the fact that the story pertains to its topic (10 points).

Scholarship applications must be postmarked no later than February 22, 2009.
