The tradition of “America’s Resort™” dates back to 1778, when guests first came to White Sulphur Springs to “take the waters” of the iconic mineral springs that run through the property. The 11,000-acre estate features 710 Signature Resort Rooms, Classic and Historic Suites, Legacy Cottages and Estate Homes.

More than 55 indoor and outdoor activities are available to guests, providing entertainment for all ages and interests in every season. Some of the most popular adventures include fishing, horseback riding, falconry, off-road driving, golf and indoor and outdoor tennis. The full-service, 40,000-square-foot mineral spa is widely recognized as one of the most luxurious in the world.

The Greenbrier Retail Collection is comprised of 35 boutiques and shops, including seven artisan shops with handmade crafts from local artists.

The Greenbrier Dining Collection includes 20 restaurants, cafes and lounges, serving award-winning cuisine prepared by internationally recognized chefs. The legendary Main Dining Room has been serving breakfast and dinner to guests since 1913.

The Casino Club at The Greenbrier is America’s only private casino, featuring 320 state-of-the-art slot machines, 35 table games and sports wagering at the FanDuel Sportsbook - in a smoke-free, upscale environment.

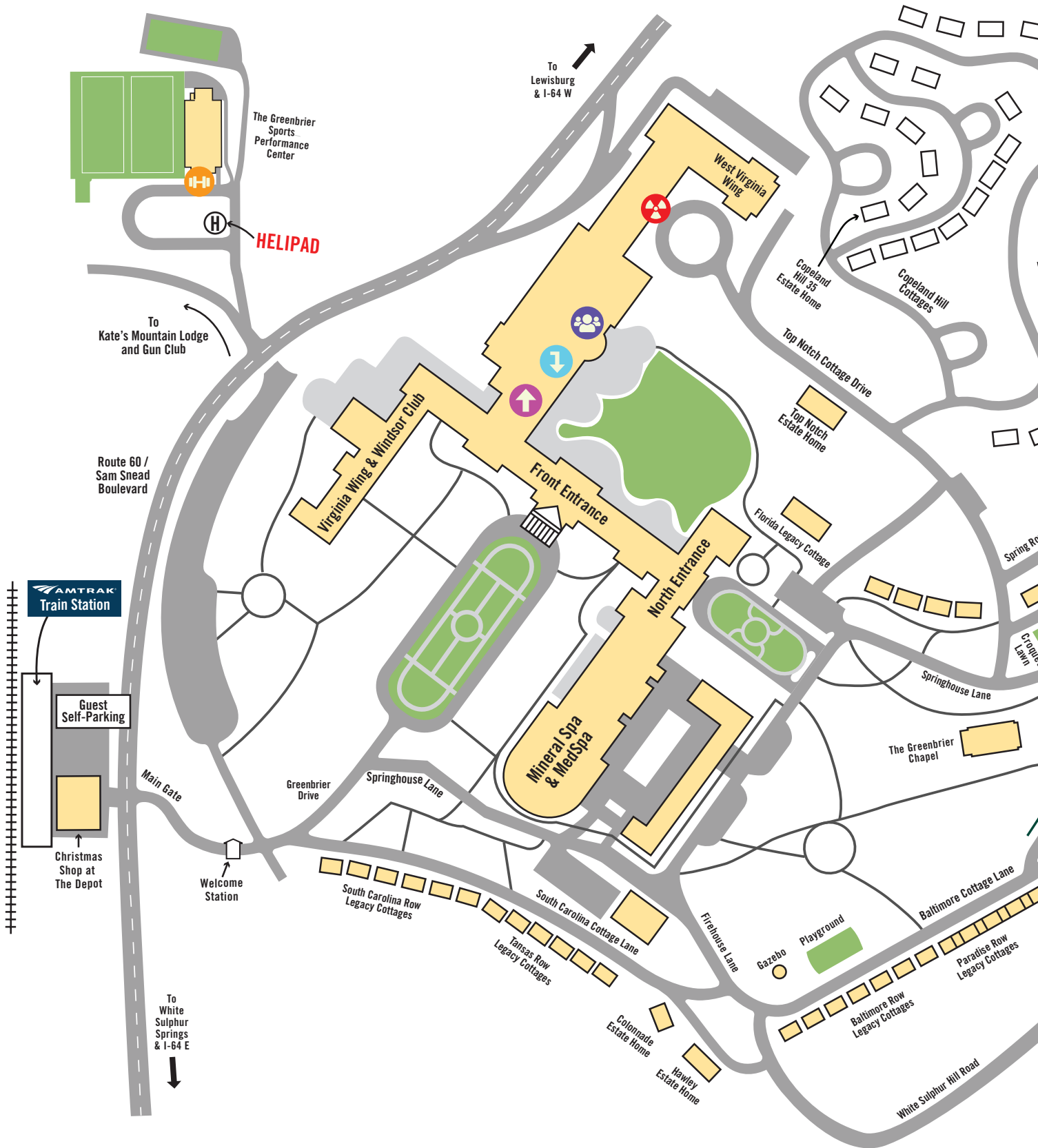
A newly renovated Conference Center provides the perfect location to stage meetings of all sizes in a facility that matches the legacy of America’s Resort. State-of-the-art technology is combined with unique Dorothy Draper design to create a functional and memorable setting for work to be completed.

Golf at The Greenbrier dates back more than a century. The Old White Course, a CB Macdonald masterpiece, debuted in 1914 and was an annual stop on the PGA TOUR from 2010 through 2019. A newly redesigned Meadows Course combines unparalleled mountain views with signature stacked sod bunkers. The Greenbrier Course, which hosted both the Ryder Cup (1979) and Solheim Cup (1994), is currently operating as a nine-hole course, and The Ashford Short Course gives golfers the opportunity to work on their short games on a 9-hole, par-3 walking course.

Major events at The Greenbrier each year include The Greenbrier Champions Tennis Classic (fall) and The Greenbrier Concours d’Elegance (spring). The Greenbrier has also hosted professional sports organizations such as the PGA TOUR, the National Football League, World TeamTennis, and world-class equestrian events.











Estate Map



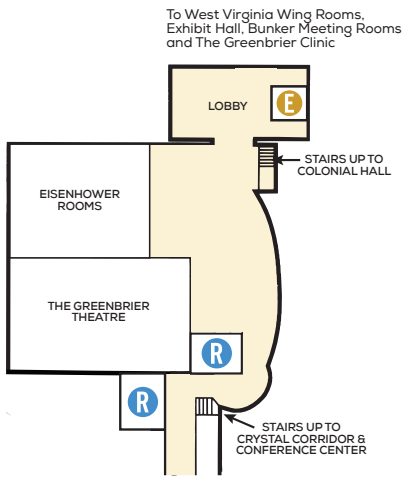

Getting to The Greenbrier

HAS NEVER BEEN EASIER

Located in the Allegheny Mountains of West Virginia, The Greenbrier is conveniently situated within a 500-mile radius of most of the East Coast, including New York, Cleveland, Indianapolis and Atlanta. America's Resort™ is less than a 5-hour drive from Charlotte, Washington, D.C., Baltimore and Pittsburgh.

SCENIC DRIVE

From Interstate 64, The Greenbrier is located less than five miles off of Exit 175 (East) or 181 (West) on Route 60.

COMMERCIAL FLIGHTS

Daily direct flights are available via Contour Airlines via American Airlines to Greenbrier Valley Airport (LWB), 15 minutes from The Greenbrier, from Charlotte-Douglas International Airport (CLT). Other major airports convenient to The Greenbrier include Roanoke, Va. (ROA, 75 minutes), Charleston, W.Va. (CRW, 85 minutes) and Beckley, W.Va. (BKW, 50 minutes), with service provided by major carriers and shuttle service to The Greenbrier available.

HISTORIC TRAIN SERVICE ON AMTRAK

Amtrak's Cardinal Route travels from New York's Penn Station to Chicago's Union Station three times per week with a stop in White Sulphur Springs, directly across the street from The Greenbrier's main entrance. To book, visit Amtrak.com.
