



Draper's Chicken Salad

FROM OUR KITCHEN TO YOURS

DRAPER'S CHICKEN SALAD

Serves 8

1 each - chicken (5 pounds)

1 cup - diced celery

2/3 cup - sour cream

11/3 cups - mayonnaise

2 Tbsp - apple cider vinegar

Salt - to taste

Freshly ground black pepper - to taste

Put chicken in a stock pot with lightly salted cold water to cover. Bring to a simmer, reduce the heat and poach gently, skimming off any foam accumulating on the surface, until the meat is very tender when pierced with a knife, 50-60 minutes. Leave chicken to cool in the poaching liquid. When cool enough to handle, remove the meat and discard any skin, fat or gristle. Dice the meat.

Mix together the diced chicken, diced celery, sour cream, mayonnaise and vinegar. Season to taste with salt and pepper. Chill well before serving.

GUN CLUB

he Greenbrier Gun Club has been around as long as The Greenbrier itself. Founded in 1913, the same year the current Greenbrier Hotel was constructed, skeet and trap have been popular pastimes at The Greenbrier for more than a century. Located atop Kate's Mountain, the Gun Club's current offerings include four combination trap and skeet fields and a 10-station sporting clays course.

he sporting clays course was designed by Justin Jones and John Higgins of the British School of Shooting and challenges shooters of all skill levels. The Gun Club provides each group of up to five shooters with a Professional Trap Attendant to ensure that each shooter has a safe and enjoyable experience while shooting Trap, Skeet or Sporting Clays.

Tennis was played as early as the 1890s out on the lawn in front of the Paradise Row cottages. In the first few years of the 20th Century, grass courts were laid out near the site of today's guest parking lots, just west of the Main Entrance. When the Golf Clubhouse (then known as 'the Casino') was built in 1915, clay courts were added in front of the building where the lower level courts are today. These were replaced with Har-Tru courts in 1937.

The most famous tennis competition at The Greenbrier was the series of Mason and Dixon Championships held between 1921 and 1937. Held each April at the height of the social season, the matches were one of final elimination rounds determining each year's participants on the Davis Cup team. As such, the matches received national attention every year. Over the years, the winners of the Mason and Dixon included Bill Tilden, Francis Hunter, Vincent Richards, George Lott, Ellsworth Vines, Francis Shields, Clifford Sutter and Bryan "Bitsy" Grant.

In 1937, The Greenbrier resigned from the USLTA in a dispute over competition between amateurs and professionals and that year hosted the first U.S. Open Tennis Tournament. For five consecutive years, professionals and amateurs competed on The Greenbrier's Har-Tru courts. To show his support for The Greenbrier's position, golf pro Sam Snead entered the tournament in 1938. At these tournaments, \$2,000 in prize money was distributed and participants were offered a special hotel rate of \$7 per day (meals included).

The Greenbrier responded to the tennis boom of the 1970's by building the 5-court Indoor Tennis facility in 1975. The facility opened to a gala party on October 15, 1975, and was the site of World Seniors Tournaments each autumn for the next five years.



THE GREENBRIER CHAMPIONS TENNIS CLASSIC NOW IN SIXTH YEAR

On Sept. 22, 2012, tennis legends Pete Sampras and John McEnroe met on the Har-Tru outdoor courts at The Greenbrier Tennis Center in an exhibition to celebrate the rich tennis history at America's Resort, and The Greenbrier Champions Tennis Classic was born.

Now in its sixth year, the annual event has grown into a two-day showcase and the matches have moved from makeshift stands on the outdoor courts to one of the most picturesque venues in the game, Center Court at Creekside. The 2,500-seat stadium on the banks of Howard's Creek opened in 2015 and is now the showpiece for tennis at The Greenbrier.

This year's event, which will take place on Saturday, Sept. 16, and Sunday, Sept. 17, will once again feature Sampras, who now serves as The Greenbrier's Tennis Professional Emeritus, but he won't be the only major draw. Venus Williams, Ana Ivanovic and James Blake will also be taking the court before a crowd full of tennis enthusiasts on the edge of their seats.

The Sept. 16 slate features a pair of singles matches. The women will go first, as Ivanovic takes on Williams at noon. Ivanovic found plenty of success during her 13-year professional career, winning the French Open and reaching No. 1 in the world in 2008. Williams has 49 career titles during her illustrious career and has reached the top spot in the world rankings in both singles and doubles. Still going strong at 37 years old, Williams advanced to the Wimbeldon finals in July.

A men's match will follow the ladies later in the afternoon on that opening day, with Sampras and Blake doing battle at 2:30 p.m. A 14-time Grand Slam winner, Sampras is widely considered one of the greatest American players of all-time. Blake, won 366 career singles matches and 10 titles, reaching No. 4 in the world during his 15-year professional career.

Doubles will be the order of the day on Sept. 17 when Sampras and Williams team together to take on Blake and Ivanovic at 12:30 p.m.

Youth and adult tickets are available for each day for both Lower Level and Upper Level seating. Weekend bundles are also available at a cost-saving price. In addition to the on-court action, autograph session tickets can be purchased, giving fans an opportunity to meet the stars.

The courts are great. You have the indoor courts and the outdoor clay. It's a great facility, and the people really support the tennis. It's exciting, and it's fun.

What does it mean to you to be The Greenbrier's Tennis Professional Emeritus?

It's a great resort. Everything is first class. The rooms are great. The food is great. Everything is here. Now tennis is elevated here, and for me to be part of it is an honor.

What other tennis events would you like to see at The Greenbrier?

A Davis Cup or a Federation Cup match would be great here. Anything to get exposure or to get new blood out here is great. There's a lot of history on these courts, and we're all really excited about it.

You will be back at The Greenbrier for The Greenbrier Champions Tennis Classic September 16-17. Once you get out on the court, do the competitive juices start flowing?

Once you start playing, you want to play well. We all have egos. But at the same time you want to make sure it's competitive and that the people enjoy it. It does get competitive. It's the natural progression of the sport.




